Sewing and Sanctuary and the Iris Café banner

Guest article by the Sewing and Sanctuary group

Sewing and Sanctuary is a women's sewing group which began in May 2022. The group was set up by Transition Town Tooting in partnership with Oxfam and CARAS. The space above Oxfam, Tooting Broadway, provides a place of sanctuary for women of refugee and asylum seeker backgrounds and women from the local community, to meet, stitch and chat.

We worked on a commission from Wandsworth Carers' Centre to make a banner for their new Iris Café. The completed banner was delivered in January and they were delighted with it.

One of our facilitators, Jeni, visited the Iris Cafe in October to find out about the interests and memories of the attendees and she fed these back into the sewing group. This inspired the appliqué motifs made by individual members of our group, for example the tomatoes which one man used to grow in Jamaica, and an artist's palette and brush for a man who was an artist.

Nicola then visited the Iris Café in November to run an activity session making pom-poms and felt flowers. This was very positive as it encouraged the attendees to talk about their hobbies and interests. These items were brought back to Oxfam and added to the banner. Various skills were learnt by the group during the making of the banner such as using machine embroidery and how to appliqué. It was a truly collaborative project.


